We spent time in January doing homework and planning. I've submitted two grant requests. We successfully implemented a new text messaging platform for retention and engagement purposes. We've focused on getting new retail products into our Center. Pictured above – new honey products that are all produced here in Jackson County. We had numerous guests ask us for honey last year, so we listened and have already sold a significant amount in January. We have one new magnet in production featuring the courthouse at Christmas in the snow. We have one new blanket product in the pipeline and will unveil this as a 'freebie' at Friends Night Out in March. We've started a co-op with our downtown billboard. We are researching a potential community gift card program with Giverrang. We've set the date for our annual golf tourney (August 30th). Our dining guide is in line at the printing company. We've done lots of research on a fundraising effort with pavers and rethinking our outdoor space here, in conjunction with our 100th anniversary. We are continuing with Hwy. 107 grants and outreach and have worked with several businesses on relocation efforts. We have three grand openings scheduled for February. We plan to offer our first Pop Up Market on Friday, May 26th – featuring 5 select vendors with their Made in American products on Memorial Day weekend. Guests and locals will enjoy this!
